TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 – No Evacuation

A strong distant earthquake occurred in Solomon Islands Region at 01:30 PM (Philippine Time), located at 10.6°N, 161.6°E with depth of 30 km and a preliminary magnitude of 7.1. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical earthquake and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coasts located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0. This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
