## **TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 – No Evacuation**

A strong distant earthquake occurred in Vanuatu Islands at 02:04 PM (Philippine Time), located at 13.6°N, 166.4°E with depth of 66 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.7. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical earthquake and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coasts located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

**PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0.** This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
