TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 – No Evacuation

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **Near Coast of Central Chile, at 06:37 AM** (Philippine Time), located at **35.1° South, 72.7° West** with depth of **10 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.2**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0. This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
