A strong teleseismic earthquake occurred in the *Near the Coast of Chiapas, Mexico* at *06:15 AM* (Philippine Time), located a *14.3°S, 92.2°W* with depth of *31* km and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.6**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

**PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0**. This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
