**No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake occurred **Near North Coast of New Guinea P.N.G at 06:55 AM** (Philippine Time), located at **3.1 South 142.6 East** with depth of **10 km** and a preliminary magnitude of **6.8**

No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
