No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred **Solomon Islands** at **09:32 AM** (Philippine Time), located at **6.4 South 154.6 East** with depth of **75 km** and a preliminary magnitude of **6.7**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
