**ADVISORY**  
**No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **Kuril Island** at **11:05 AM** on **April 19, 2013** (Philippine Time), located at **46.2° North, 150.9° East** with depth of **10 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.0**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
