TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 0 – No Evacuation

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **Southeastern Alaska at 4:58 PM** (Philippine Time), located at **55.3° North, 134.9° West** with depth of **5 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.7**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data according to Pacific Tsunami Warning Center. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami ALERT Level is 0. This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
