No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred *Mariana Islands* at *(08:32AM)* (Philippine Time), located at *18.8N*, *145.4°E* with depth of *566* km and a **preliminary magnitude of *7.0***. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
