ADVISORY

No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **the Sea of Okhotsk** at **1:45 PM** (Philippine Time), located at **54.7° North, 153.4° East** with depth of **619 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 8.2**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
