**ADVISORY**  
**No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake occurred near the **East Coast of Kamchatka, Russia** at **03:04 PM** (Philippine Time), November 12, 2013, located at **54.6° North, 162.3° East** with depth of **57 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.6**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
