## **ADVISORY No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **Taiwan** at **08:02 PM** (Philippine Time), October 31, 2013, located at **23.5° North, 121.3 ° East** with depth of **10 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.7**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coasts located within a hundred kilometers of the earthquake epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
