ADVISORY No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred **Near the Coast of Northern Chile** at **10:43 AM** (Philippine Standard Time), located at **20.5° South Latitude, 70.4° West Longitude** with a depth of **10 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.4**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.

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
