ADVISORY No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred at Guerrero, Mexico at **10:27 PM** (Philippine Time), **April 18, 2014**, located at **17.6° North, 100.9 ° West** with depth of **52 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.4**. No destructive widespread tsunami threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coasts located within a hundred kilometers of the earthquake epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
