## **ADVISORY** No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred in Molucca Sea at 07:44 PM (Philippine Time), located at 2.2 North, 126.8 East with depth of 66 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.6. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
