No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred in **Near the coast of Chiapas, Mexico** at **7:24 PM** (Philippine Time), located at **14.8° North, 92.6° West** with depth of **33 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 7.1**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
