No Tsunami Threat

A strong distant earthquake occurred **Rat Islands, Aleutian Islands, Alaska** at **11:16 AM** (Philippine Time), located at 52.0°N, 176.7°E with depth of **26km** and a **M6.6**. No destructive West Philippine Sea-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
