## **ADVISORY**

### **No Tsunami Threat**

A strong distant earthquake occurred near the coast of **Kepulauan Sula, Indonesia** at **10:46 AM** (Philippine Time), located at **0.4° South, 125.1° East** with depth of **69 km** and a **preliminary magnitude of 6.5**. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data. However, earthquakes of this size sometimes generate local tsunamis that can be destructive along coast located within a hundred kilometers of the epicenter.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.
